General Guidelines

- ❖ This competition is designed to improve the English Language skills of 1st and 2nd year students in the Faculty of Applied Sciences.
- This competition will be held on an online platform via zoom.
- The competition contains five categories of contests,
 - Debate
 - Storytelling/Poem/Lyrics
 - Speech
 - Drama
 - Singing (Solo, Duet & Groups)
- ❖ It is compulsory to participate all students from 1st and 2nd year students of each degree program with above five categories of contests.
- ❖ Each degree program must participate in every event.
- **Each** student must participate at least in one of the above mentioned contests.
- One student can participate in a maximum of two events.
- Cash prices will be awarded for the winners of each contest.
- Students must get into groups within their degree program without any mixing in degree wise or batch wise.
- ❖ Each participant should register through the given Google sheet on or before 1st of February.
- ❖ Google sheets will be emailed through the relevant group mails of each degree program.
- Relevant terms and conditions for each event are given below.

Terms and Conditions

Medium of Presenting is essentially English

Debate

- The topics will be given by the judge panel before the competition date.
- Each group should consist of 5 members.
- Each speaker will have 4 minutes in the first round and 2 minutes for the leader to summarize the points.
- Each group should select a leader and submit the names of their team members in the shared Google sheet.

Storytelling/Poem/Lyrics

- This is an individual event.
- Contestants should build up a story based on a given set of images.
- Images will be provided at the time of competition.
- 5 minutes will be allocated for each contestant.
- Poem or Lyrics should be presented based on pre-selected (own) topic
- Storytelling and Poem/Lyrics will be evaluated separately

Speech

- This is an individual event.
- Topics will be given at the time of the event.
- Each speaker should speak at least about 5 minutes.

Drama

- Group event
- Maximum number of members should be limited to 8.
- Each member should actively take part in dialogs.
- Group members are able to score more on the creativity of their activity.
- Time limitation for each drama will be 15 minutes.

Singing

- This contest will be held under 3 subcategories (Solo, Duet and Group singing).
- Each subcategory will be evaluated separately.
- Maximum number of participants for each group should not exceed 5 members.
